

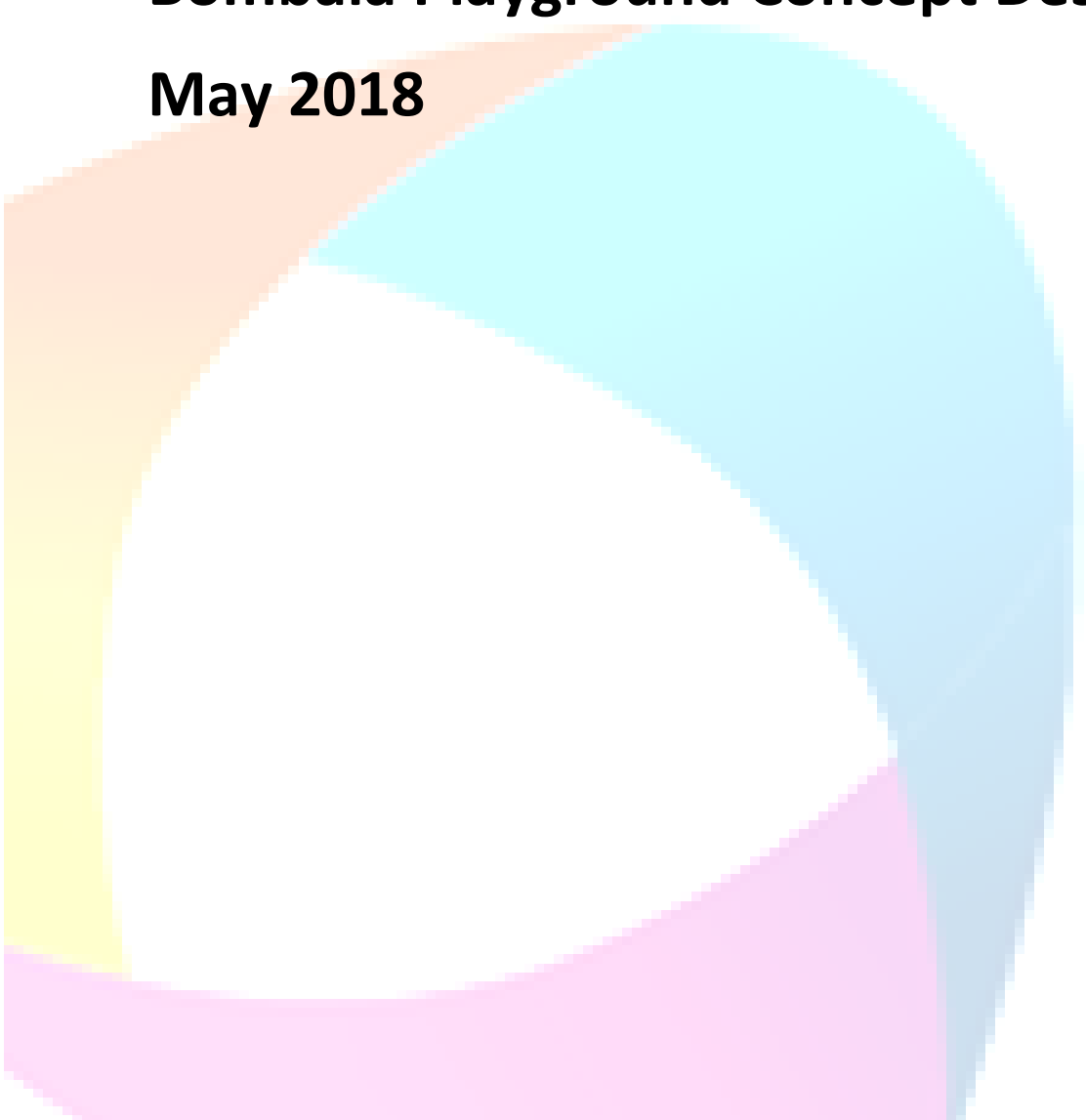

# **Consultation Summary**

**Bombala Playground Concept Design**

**May 2018**



## Summary

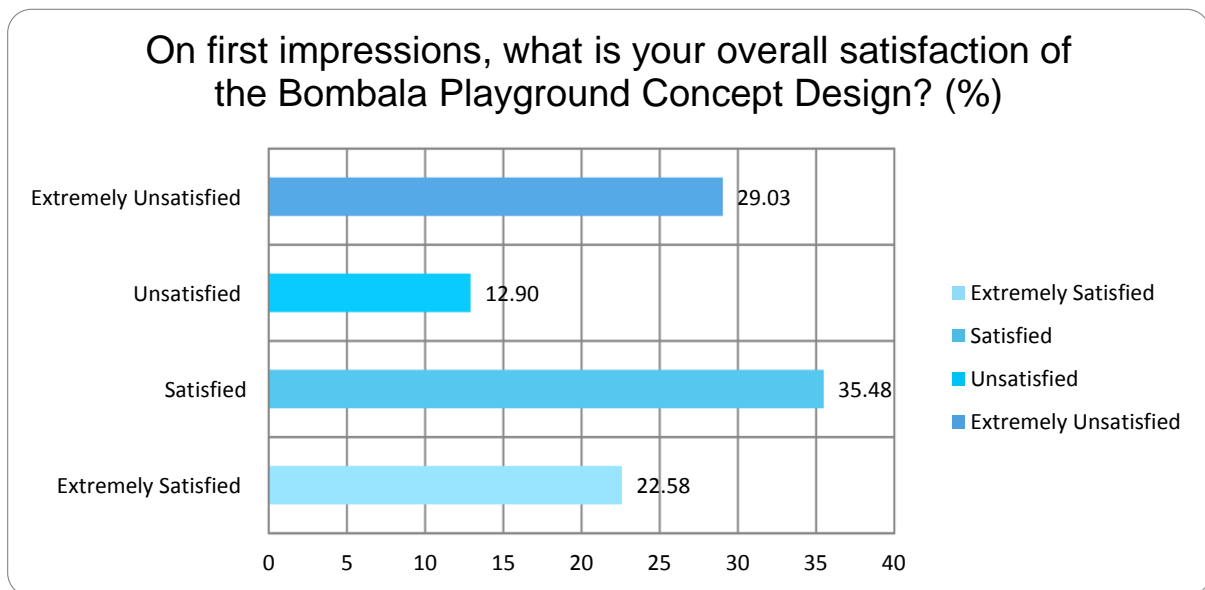
The Bombala Playground Concept Designs were released for consultation online via the Snowy Monaro Regional Council Your Say website on 16 April 2018 and participation closed on 3 May 2018.

- 133 visitors attended the Your Say site to view the Concept Designs.
- 31 people completed the QuickPoll to give us a gauge of overall satisfaction ratings. Further information detailed below of results.
- 27 submissions were made on the more detailed survey which allowed feedback on specific items of equipment and general comments on the Concept Designs put forward.

## QuickPoll

The QuickPoll was fairly balanced in responses, in favour of more satisfied, than not.

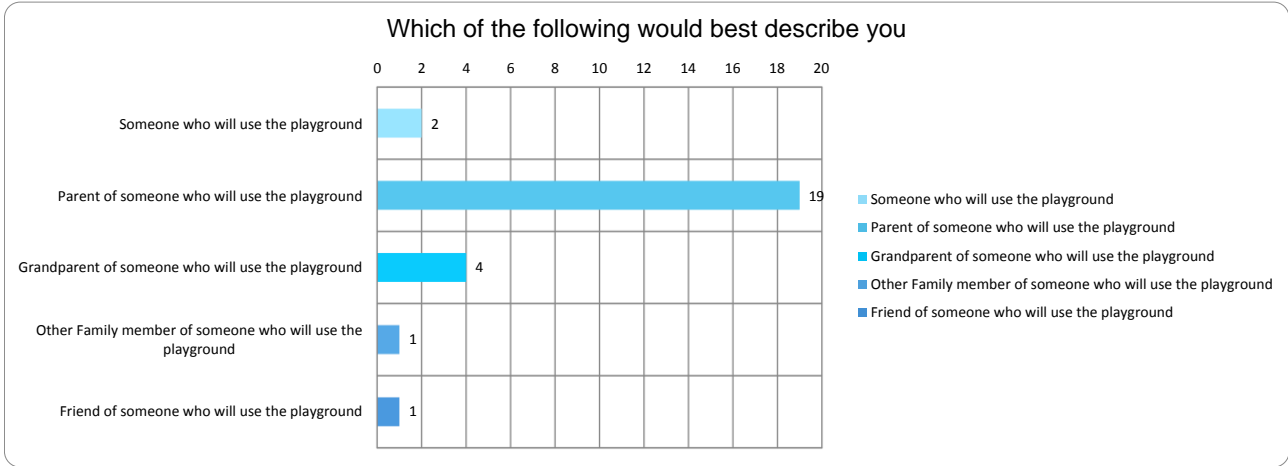
A combined 58% of responses indicated a Satisfied and Extremely Satisfied impression of the Bombala Playground Concept Design. The remaining 42% of responses indicated a combined Unsatisfied and Extremely Unsatisfied first impression.



## Survey

The Survey tool which was included as part of consultation was only completed by 20% of visitors to the Your Say website.

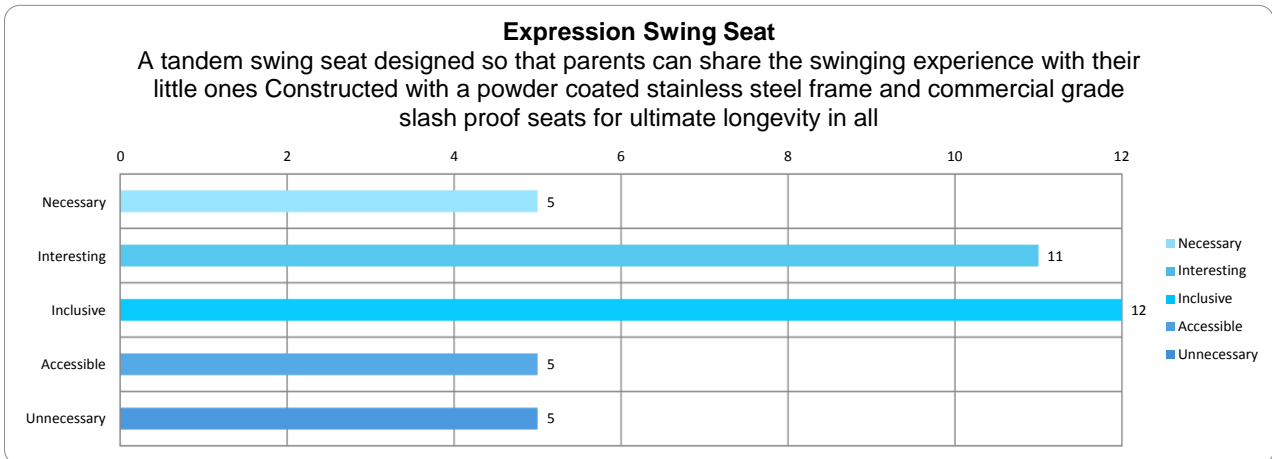
Of the 20% who completed the survey, 70% answered that they were a parent of someone who would use the playground (19 out of the 27 submissions).



Throughout the survey, targeted responses were sought to determine thoughts on specific items for within the playground.

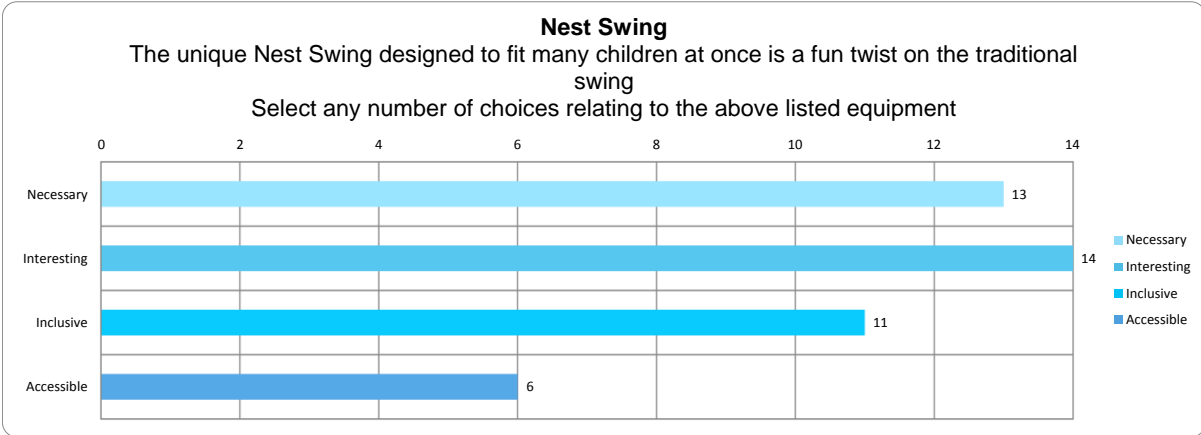
### Expression Swing Seat:

Responses indicate very positive feelings towards the equipment while its necessity is balanced as equal for its inclusion in the final design.



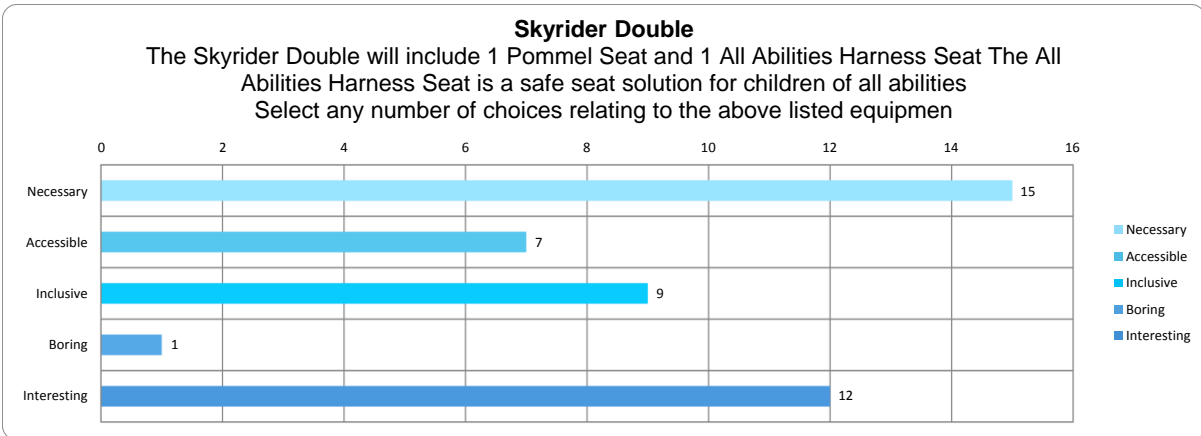
**Nest Swing:**

Responses indicate extremely positive feelings towards the equipment and its necessity is very well supported for its inclusion in the final design.



**Skyrider Double:**

Responses again indicate extremely positive feelings towards the equipment with only 1 negative response. Its necessity is also very well supported for its inclusion in the final design.



The unsatisfied responses from the QuickPoll were supported within the Survey comments section and included the following themed concerns / feedback from submissions made:

Concern / Feedback	Snowy Monaro Regional Council Response
Shading requirements over equipment	Insufficient funding for current project scope
	Future funding opportunity
Design does not provide much for small children age group	Contractor has been given approval for the inclusion of an extra piece of playground equipment for the younger age group
	Sandpit digger from current playground to be retained and incorporated into next playground design
Standard all abilities swings should not be removed	Existing swing and old slide in other of park to remain

**July to August 2018** – Site Works
