Summary

Representatives from Snowy Monaro Regional Council (SMRC) attended Cathcart Memorial Hall on Tuesday 22 May 2018 to present initial sketches and concepts for the upcoming Stronger Communities Fund Major Projects Program (SFMP) - Streetscape enhancement project.

This community meeting allowed SMRC to highlight the different features of the proposal and feedback was obtained from the attendees. These concepts were then further developed into the preliminary designs.

The Cathcart Streetscape Designs were then released for public consultation via SMRC’s Your Say website on 4 July 2018 and consultation closed on 25 July 2018.

21 visitors attended the Cathcart Streetscape Your Say site during this period.

1 submission was made to the survey.

Although Cathcart’s Your Say survey did not achieve the levels of participation as expected, other forms community feedback and support from SMRC’s heritage consultant indicate support for this project.

Survey results

The survey tool which was included as part of online consultation was completed by a number of visitors to the Your Say website, totalling 5%.

On first impressions, what is your overall satisfaction of the Cathcart streetscape concept design?

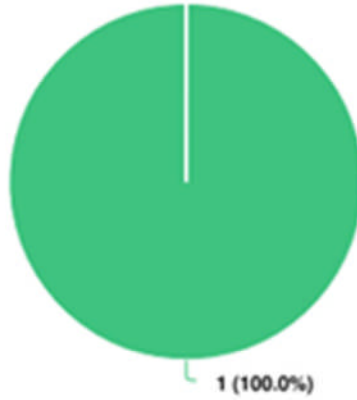

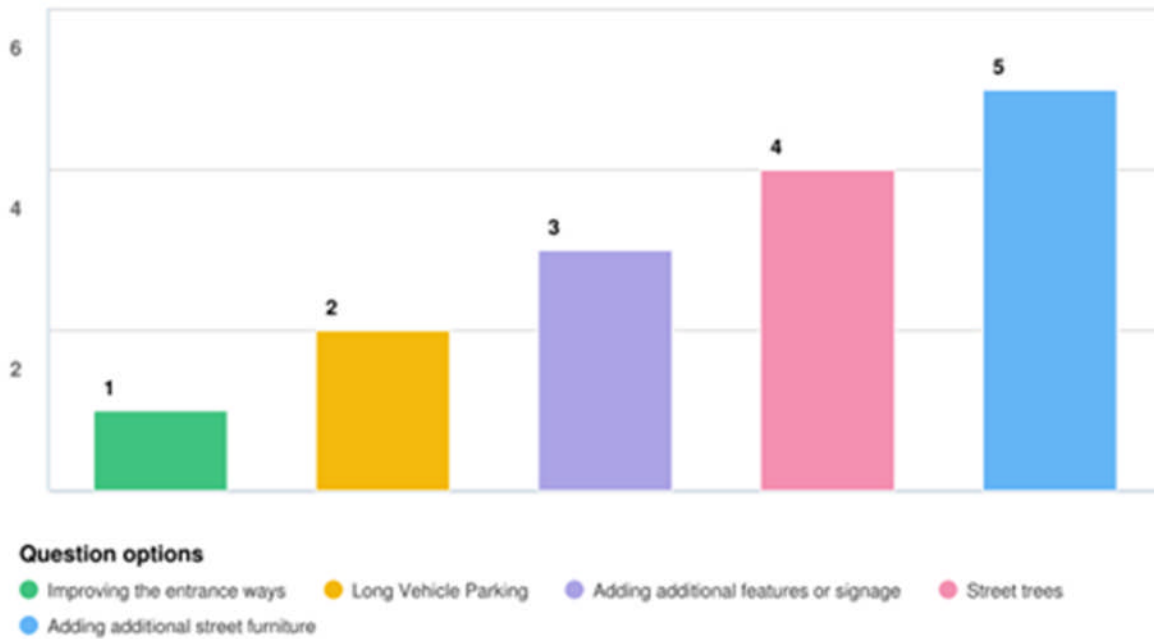
