Summary

Representatives from Snowy Monaro Regional Council attended Dalgety Community Hall on Wednesday 23 May 2018 to present initial sketches and concepts for the upcoming Stronger Communities Fund Major Projects Program (SFMP) - Streetscape enhancement project.

This community meeting allowed SMRC to highlight the different features of the proposal and feedback was obtained from the attendees. These concepts were then further developed into the preliminary designs.

The Dalgety Streetscape Designs were then released for public consultation via SMRC’s Your Say website on 4 July 2018 and consultation closed on 25 July 2018.

26 visitors attended the Dalgety Streetscape Your Say site during this period.

5 submissions were made to the survey

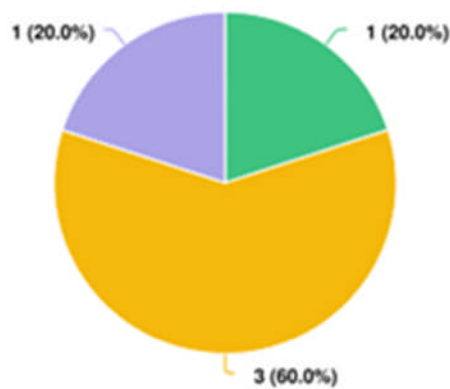
Survey results

The survey tool which was included as part of online consultation was completed by a number of visitors to the Your Say website, totalling 17%.

First impressions and overall satisfaction

The initial question targeted a response to measure first impressions and overall satisfaction towards the Dalgety Streetscape design. The results indicate that the design has had a positive response with the majority supporting the concepts.

- Minor changes to improve

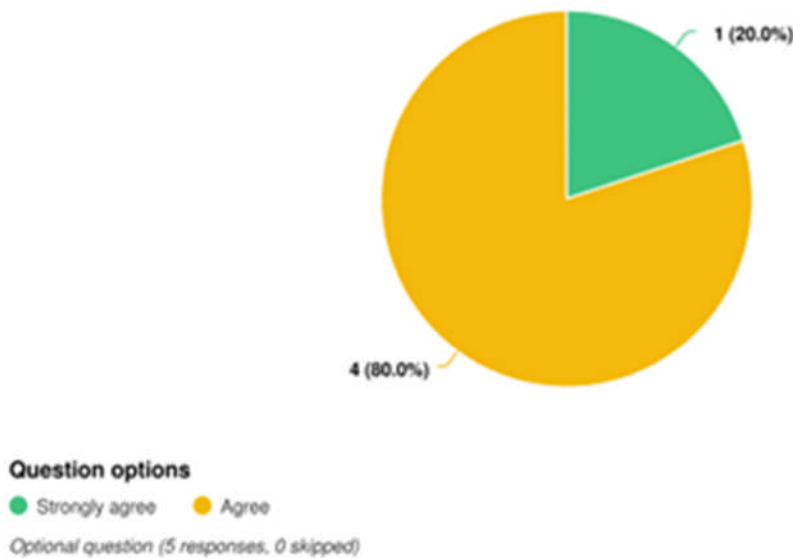

Theming and style

Dalgety already having a fantastic area at the Riverside Park with the iconic features of the Iron Bridge and the Snowy River Weir have provided the ideal platform to attract visitors and give travellers a space to stop and rest.

Concept designs aimed to continue the current theme and style and the results from the survey would indicate that this element was achieved with results highlighting more than 80% support towards the project.

Does this proposed design capture the correct theme and style of Dalgety?

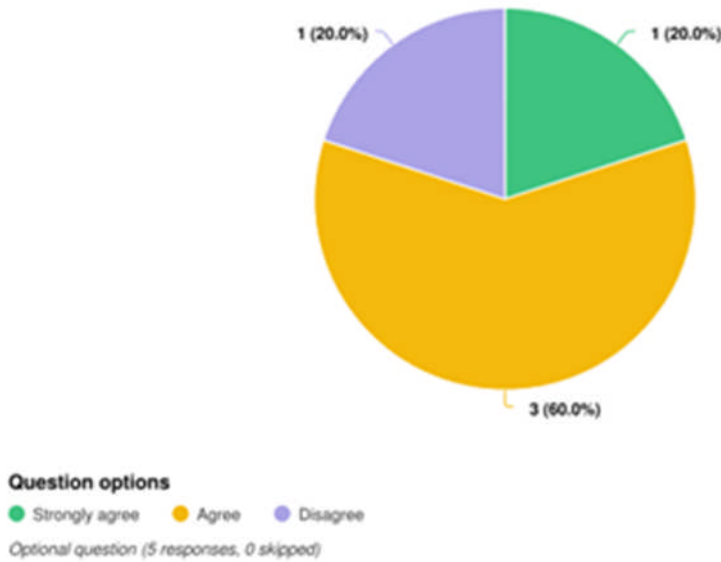


Parking and improved access

The project element of improving parking and access has achieved strong support. With limited areas to improve parking in the Village, the access entrance to the Riverside Park is a focus point for this project. Survey results indicate this target area has achieved strong support.

Survey results have shown 80% support for the design’s parking proposals.

Has this design allowed for improved access and parking to visitors and travellers?

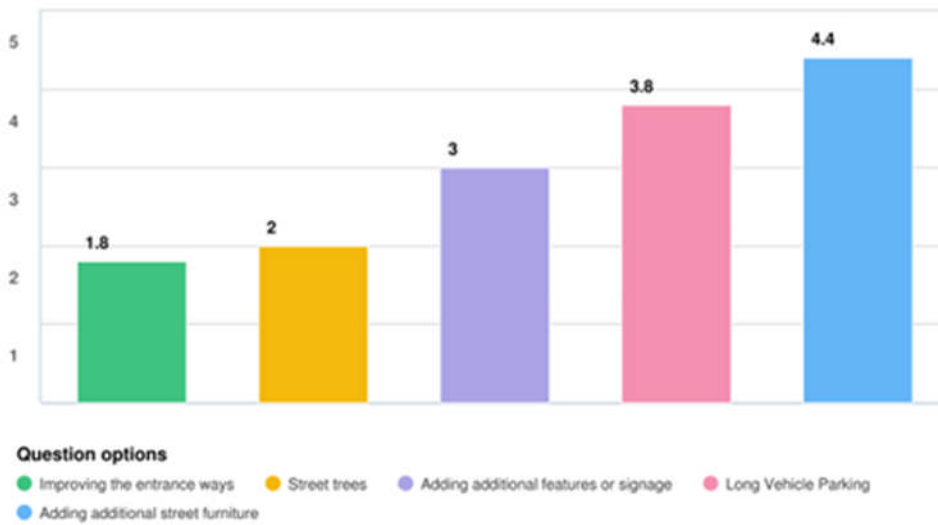


Priorities

Survey participants indicate that the addition of street furniture and long vehicle parking to a Streetscape design is a priority. As previously mentioned, there are limited options to provide additional long vehicle parking in the Village, however provisions for more street furniture have been allocated in the design.

An opportunity to provide custom tree guards with local features will also enhance the aesthetics and feel of the township, whilst providing visitors with interesting features and historical information.

Open comments

The final question within the Survey was open ended and SMRC welcomed the feedback and comments from those who participated. The question asked was:

The submissions made have been themed and summarised below. SMRC has offered a response alongside.

Community Response	Snowy Monaro Regional Council Response
Evergreen trees	Tree selection is part of the design specifications and Evergreen varieties are being considered.
Sign to include platypus	An opportunity to provide custom signs and tree guards with local features will also enhance the overlook and feel of the township whilst providing visitors with interesting features and historical information.
Shrubs rather than trees	Shrub selection is part of the design specifications and low height varieties being considered.

Conclusion

The Dalgety Streetscape concepts will now be further developed into design level documents and specifications to be defined, ready to go to tender.
