




Mountain biking

JINDABYNE


The ultimate adventurer's playground, Jindabyne is a popular holiday destination year-round. Its proximity to Kosciuszko National Park and the major ski resorts of New South Wales make it an ideal stop. During winter, ski or ride the alpine mountains at Thredbo, Perisher or Charlotte Pass enjoying all the winter season has to offer. Explore the area in the summer when locals and tourists alike take to boating and watersports on Lake Jindabyne, mountain biking, fishing and nature-filled walking tracks.

BOMBALA

Bombala lies on the banks of the Bombala River in the southern part of the Snowy Monaro region. The town is easily accessible from the snowfields or the south coast. Brimming with local farmlands and waterways, it is home to the local platypus population. Keen anglers can try their hand at trout fishing in the rivers surrounding the area.

COOMA


Capital of the Snowy Mountains, Cooma is the largest town in the region and is located on the Monaro Highway one hour from Canberra and Jindabyne. Cooma is set amongst the beautiful rolling Monaro Plains and legendary rivers.

Cooma is the home of Snowy Hydro. When construction of the Snowy Mountains Scheme commenced in 1949, Cooma grew into a multicultural hub. Find out about the past, present and future of the mighty Snowy Scheme, Snowy Hydro and renewables at the Snowy Hydro Discovery Centre.


ADAMINABY



Adaminaby is the home of the Big Trout, hailing anglers year-round for ample fishing in the historic Lake Eucumbene. The town of Adaminaby has a rich history. It was relocated in 1956, earning it both an old and new township. Travel from Adaminaby to ski, ride or toboggan at Selwyn Snow Resort. Kosciuszko National Park is located on its doorstep, making Adaminaby the ideal base to explore the region and all it has to offer.

BERRIDALE

Berridale is located in the heart of the Snowy Mountains, nestled between Cooma and Jindabyne. Set amongst a scenic landscape characterised by unique granite boulder outcrops, it is a haven for photographers. The poplar-lined main street welcomes visitors into a charming village as they explore their way around the alpine region.

Stay safe on the roads

The Snowy Mountains are a unique part of Australia to visit. Stop, play and discover all the local towns when visiting the area. The region has a lot to offer, so take your time and have regular stops.

When travelling through the Snowy Mountains be aware of the diverse landscape. The roads are narrow and the weather can change without warning. Please be patient while driving and consider where the best and safest places are to stop. Trucks will be travelling on the roads, so be patient with them as they will pull over in designated truck bays and let you pass safely.

During winter, you may be required to carry and/or fit wheel chains to your vehicle depending on weather conditions. Check the regulations before you travel to ensure you are prepared for the road conditions. Please note roads may be closed at any time with short notice during inclement weather and winter road regulations are enforceable by authorities.

If you're planning to drive into Kosciuszko National Park you must have a valid NSW National Parks pass for your vehicle. During normal operating hours, you can buy a day pass or multi-day pass from vehicle entry stations, local NPWS visitor centres, the Thredbo Visitor Centre or the NPWS Perisher Valley Office.


