Purpose of this application form

This application should be completed by a consumer that seeks to acquire a Perpetual Interment Right at a Council managed cemetery. This form is in accordance with requirements of Cemeteries & Crematoria NSW under subsection 56(2) of the *Cemeteries and Crematoria Act 2013*.

- ONE application is required for EACH Perpetual Interment Right.
- Once the application and payment has been received, you will be issued with an Interment Right. Once received you should keep this document in a safe place. It is recommended you file with your Will and Executor.
- The Perpetual Interment Right does not cover additional costs incurred such as funeral director, headstone, plaque or burial expenses
- Prior to the purchase of any plot that all applicants MUST make themselves aware of Council policy on Plaques and Monuments for the respective cemeteries.

Conditions in relation to an interment right

The following conditions apply to the Interment Right Holder:

- The interment right holder has the sole right to decide and advise the Council about who may be buried, have ashes placed or be memorialized in the site.
- An interment Right is a contract between a cemetery operator (Council) and a right holder permitting the right holder to undertake burials in a particular grave in a cemetery.
- An Interment Right is an 'interest' in land but the right holder does not become the owner of the land.
- Interment rights apply to burial in the earth and also burials in mausoleums, crypts and vaults. They also apply to burials of cremated remains in the earth or in a columbarium or niche wall.
- An Interment Right allows the right holder to bury human remains in a particular grave in a cemetery and for those remains to be left undisturbed (in perpetuity).
- The Interment Right and General Conditions and in accordance with Council's policies and procedures and current fees and charges as agreed to by Council and Cemeteries and Crematoria Act 2013.
- An Interment Right may be varied, transferred, cancelled upon application to Council accordance with current policies and procedures.
- The right granted to the Interment Right Holder will be dealt with as part of the personal estate upon death.
- If the Interment Right holder and/or family are responsible for the maintaining of headstones or memorials in a safe and proper condition. This is not the responsibility of the cemetery.

Payment Arrangement

On receipt of your form, the applicant will be sent an Invoice, payment of the invoice confirms your reservation.

The information is required for assessment of your application, which may not be accepted or processed if all of the requested information is not provided.
