Enhancement Fund Application Guidelines

Overarching objectives

- Deliver community wide benefits;
- Encourage local community innovation and support for issues of community significance; &
- Promote local awareness and education supporting the benefits of sustainable renewable energy.

Criteria

Applicants need to be able to demonstrate the following

- Applicants are restricted to the former Cooma LGA or former Bombala LGA areas.
- Community benefit
- Community participation and/or support
- · Thorough financial planning and project management
- Joint funding sources (cash or in-kind) if applicable
- Project timelines
- Value for money

Application and funding guidelines

- Requests for applications will be advertised by Snowy Monaro Regional Council annually between July and October.
- Applications must be made on the appropriate form
- It is a requirement that quotes be submitted with the application under the following conditions;
 - For items under \$5,000 one quote required,
 - For items between \$5,001 and \$15,000 two quotes required, and
 - For items over \$15,000 three quotes required.

Applications without the appropriate quotes will not be considered.

- Applications will be considered by all members of the Boco Rock Community Enhancement Fund Committee unless they declare a conflict of interest.
- A funding agreement must be signed prior to release of funds.
- Recipients must acknowledge the source of funding.
- For long term projects a quarterly progress report will be required over the life of the project. Reporting requirements will be discussed with successful applicants.
- Unexpended funds must be returned within one month of the project completion and cannot be retained for other purposes.
- Funds must be expended within twelve months of receipt.

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- Applications may be made for projects spanning multiple years, and if approved by the Committee funding will be provided on an annual basis for the duration of the project.
- Depending on the size of the project, funding may not be paid in a single lump sum.
- Distribution of funding will be discussed with successful applicants.
- An acquittal within one month of the project completion is required to verify expenditure of the funds.
- If an organisation chooses to make a co-funding application by way of cash or in-kind support they must clearly demonstrate details in the application.
- Unallocated Boco Rock Community Enhancement funds will be carried over to the following year.
- If work is to be undertaken on a Council owned asset the written consent of Council is required.

Event Funding

- Funding is open to event organisers to assist with growing their event.
- Funding may be used to improve promotion of the event and or to improve identified aspects of the event.
- Funding cannot be used to pay wages.
- Business and Marketing Plans are required as part of the supporting document that is provided with the completed application.

Applications not eligible for funding

The following types of applications will not be eligible for consideration
