EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Monaro Committee for Cancer Research are holding a function 'Calendar Girls'. All proceeds are redirected back in to the community to support those affected by cancer.

The mCCR have requested that Council waive fees associated with the use of the Multifunction Centre.

The following officer's recommendation is submitted for Council's consideration.

OFFICER'S RECOMMENDATION

That Council

- A. Receive and note the request to waive fees for the use of the Multifunction Centre by the Monaro Committee for Cancer Research;
- B. Authorise the expenditure and allocate \$2844 in the 2017/2018 Budget to cover the costs of the Multifunction Centre with funding to be provided from the Donations Community Groups budget; and
- C. Allow the Committee to erect a temporary extension to the front of the stage for performance purposes.

BACKGROUND

The Monaro Committee for Cancer Research was formed in 1997 in an effort to aid those who are affected by cancer and to provide funding for research. The major share of monies raised has been

used for creating assistance for cancer care nurses caring for patients in the Monaro region. In addition, equipment has been purchased for Delegate, Bombala and Cooma Health services.

In 2012 the Committee founded the Financial Assistance Scheme which provides assistance to families who are facing a cancer diagnosis. The Scheme offers assistance with household bills, fuel and medical expenses.

The Monaro Committee for Cancer Research has held a number of major fundraising events that have received major community support.

The Committee are holding another fundraiser in 2017, in which various committee members and Cooma Little Theatre performers will be presenting the play 'Calendar Girls'. The fundraiser will be held on 7, 8 and 9 September 2017 in the Multifunction Centre.

Events, as well as donations, have resulted in over \$1,000,000 being raised since 1997.

The mcCr are requesting the following:

- D. Waiver of fees for use of the Multifunction Centre and any costs associated with use between 4 – 10 September 2017 (\$2,340)
- E. Access to the Multifunction Centre to rehearse for an hour for 2 nights per week from 17 July (\$504)
- F. Erect a temporary extension to the front of the stage for performance purposes

In 2015, the former Cooma-Monaro Shire Council resolved (106/15) to provide the Committee with a \$500 donation towards the hire of the Multifunction Centre. A further resolution was made (155/15) to provide additional funding for the dress rehearsals and performances for the Strictly Musical function from the Economic Development Fund.

QUADRUPLE BOTTOM LINE REPORTING

1. Social

Such fundraising events organised by the Monaro Committee for Cancer Research provide a family friendly experience that supports residents of the region undergoing cancer treatment. Such events remove the stigma around cancer and encourage awareness, social inclusion and support. It also sources money for refurbishment of facilities and research.
