

COVID-19 GROUP GUIDELINES

To ensure we comply with COVID-19 regulations around gatherings, there will be changes to the way our groups operate. These guidelines have been compiled under the advice of NSW Department of Health and are designed to keep us all safe. - To ensure we comply with rules around capacity and social distancing, you must RSVP to attend group activities. If the number of people wishing to attend exceeds our capacity we may arrange additional groups to meet demand.

- Please sign in and out at reception when entering and leaving the Centre. Both Centres have Service
 NSW QR codes which can be used to check in using a smartphone. If you do not have a smartphone,
 reception staff will check you in using the Service NSW website. Please note that your details are
 stored securely with Service NSW and will only be used for contact tracing in the event of a confirmed
 case of COVID-19 at either venue.
- Please use hand sanitiser provided when entering and leaving the Centre.
- The Centres will only be open for group activities during the specified timeframes. Access will not
 be available to the centres outside of these times. This allows staff time for essential tasks such as
 sanitising surfaces before and after use by group participants.
- Please ensure you maintain a physical distance of at least 1.5 metres from others. To make this
 easier we ask that, unless using the bathroom, you remain seated whilst attending centres.
 Please do not enter the kitchen or access items from the cupboards. Our tables will be set up at
