We were delighted to receive the Lakelight Sculpture Encouragement Award for 'Seasons of Change'. With so many members of our groups, friends, family and Community Services staff contributing everything from knitted and crocheted squares, flowers, toadstools, autumn leaves, animals, insects and pom poms, this truly was a community project! The weather over Easter was perfect, and our colourful installation looked amazing in the day and stunning when illuminated in the evening. With over 150 entries in the exhibition, winning an award is a fantastic achievement and a lovely conclusion to our yarn bombing project.



The National Zoo and Aquarium (NZA) first opened in 1990 as the National Aquarium. The Aquarium consisted of approximately 30 different species, a large restaurant and function area, with its main feature being a significant 1.5 million litre aquarium with an underwater viewing tunnel. The underwater viewing tunnel was reportedly the first of its type in the world and was manufactured by a local Canberra company. The NZA is a privately owned 19-hectare zoo and Aquarium in the Australian capital city of Canberra. It is located in Yarralumla at the western end of Lake Burley Griffin, next to Scrivener Dam. Today will allow you to participate in a guided tour and explore at your leisure.





COVID-19 GROUP GUIDELINES

IEC

To ensure we comply with COVID-19 regulations around gatherings, there will be changes to the way our groups operate. These guidelines have been compiled under the advice of NSW Department of Health and are designed to keep us all safe as our community becomes more active. - To ensure we comply with rules around capacity and social distancing, you must RSVP to attend group activities. If the number of people wishing to attend exceeds our capacity we may arrange additional groups to meet demand.
- Please do not attend if you have any of the following symptoms, even if they are only mild:
 - o Fever
 - o Cough
 - o Sore/scratchy throat
 - Shortness of breath

NSW Department of Health advises that anybody displaying the above symptoms should be tested for COVID-19. You will be asked to declare that you are not displaying any of the above symptoms upon entering the Centre.

- Please sign in and out at reception when entering and leaving the Centre. We now have Service
 NSW QR codes at both the Werri-Nina and Bombala Community Centres which can be used to check
 in using a smartphone. If you do not have a smartphone, reception staff will check you in using the
 Service NSW website. Please note that your details are stored securely with Service NSW and will only
 be used for contact tracing in the event of a confirmed case of Covid-19 at either venue.
- Please use hand sanitiser provided when entering and leaving the Centre.
- The Centres will only be open for group activities during the specified timeframes. Access will not be available to the centres outside of these times. This allows staff time for essential tasks such as sanitising surfaces before and after use by group participants.
- Please ensure you maintain a physical distance of at least 1.5 metres from others. To make this
 easier we ask that, unless using the bathroom, you remain seated whilst attending centres.
 Please do not enter the kitchen or access items from the cupboards. Our tables will be set up at
 appropriate distance and craft supplies, tissues and hand sanitiser will be provided at each table.
- Practice good hand hygiene by washing your hands thoroughly for at least 20 seconds with soap and water, or an alcohol based hand rub. Cover your nose and mouth when coughing or sneezing with a tissue or flexed elbow.
- To minimise cash handling we will be invoicing you for groups attendance and Community Transport on a monthly basis.
