- B. Award donations and sponsorship to the applications that achieve the highest collective scores in order as ranked within the budget set out in the policy.

#### ISSUES

The attached document provided as a late report is a summary of the scores awarded by councillors to applicants in the Donations and Sponsorship 2022 program. The score summary is intended to be read in conjunction with the 'Donations and Sponsorship 2022' report and inform decisions about allocation of funding.

The collation and ranking of scores from 11 councillors allows for an equitable and transparent merit based process of awarding funds based on a collective determination. The attachment contains the collated scores of the responses received so far. The remaining scores will be collated at the meeting and final results published in the minutes of the meeting.

### **BACKGROUND**

The current round of applications opened on 4 April 2022 advertising the application criteria and conditions. Council received 37 submissions. 10 met all the application criteria. The others partially met the criteria including two submissions received after the application closure date.

The applications were provided to councillors on 6 June 2022 to be scored by each according to the criteria set out in the policy.
