HELPFUL TIPS FOR RECYCLING...

RIGID PLASTIC

CONTAINERS AND TRAYS

Take the lids off and recycle separately. Remove the soft plastic top and discard, recycle the rigid plastic tray. Tip out whatever is left in the container and give it a rinse. Small food or liquid residue is OK.

GLASS JARS & BOTTLES

Lids are to be removed, but can be recycled. Tip out whatever is left in the container and give it a rinse.

ALL PAPER

No need to remove the windows from envelopes or the staples from documents.

DISPOSABLE ONE-USE COFFEE CUPS

Disposable one use coffee cups can be recycled, please empty any leftover liquids and separate lid from cup for disposal.

AEROSOL CANS

Please put only EMPTY aerosol cans into the recycle bin or take them to your local landfill or transfer station for recycling.

CARDBOARD

No need to remove the plastic insert from Tissue Boxes. Pizza boxes can go into your recycling bin even if they have leftover oil residue on them.

ALUMINIUM CANS, TRAYS AND FOIL

Rolling the foil into a ball makes it easier to recycle. It is okay if there is food residue on the foil.

STEEL CANS

Tip out whatever is left in the can and rinse.

HERE'S WHY...

PLASTIC BAGS

Currently plastic bags are not recyclable; however Council is looking at recycling options for disposal of plastic bags.

FOOD SCRAPS

Food and Garden organics are to be placed in the red lidded waste bin, this is with the exception of those households that have been provided with a lime green lidded bin for food and organics collection.

NAPPIES

Nappies are not recyclable and are very unpleasant on the sorting line at the Materials Recovery Facility.

CLOTHING & FABRIC

Our household system cannot recycle fabric and it jams the sorting machinery at the Materials Recovery Facility.

POLYSTYRENE FOAM

Polystyrene is a very low grade material with almost no value and can be difficult to melt down and reuse. It is often contaminated with food or drink, and it is difficult to clean because it is so porous.




RECYCLING FORTNIGHTLY



TO ENSURE THAT YOUR WASTE OR RECYCLING IS COLLECTED, PLEASE REMEMBER THE FOLLOWING POINTS:

1. Keep bins and crates away from objects such as letter boxes, power boxes, overhanging branches and parked cars.
2. Missed collections, missing or damaged bins must be reported to Council as soon as possible.
3. If you wish to order a new service, contact your closest office branch, or visit Council's website www.snowymonaro.nsw.gov.au to download an application form. Bins that are not Council provided will NOT be collected.
4. Place your bin out the night before collection day.
5. The collection routes are scheduled on days NOT times.
6. The collection vehicles may drive past your property very early in the morning.
7. Any bins that are not presented at the time the collection vehicle drive past your property will have to wait until the next collection day for that area.
8. Resource & Waste calendars may be downloaded from Council's website or contact council directly and one can be posted to you.
9. Present bins as front of bin to the kerb.
