In accordance with Schedule 9A to the Local Government (General) Regulation 2021, a person may apply to be a candidate in a countback election if the person:

- a) was a candidate at the original election, and
- b) did not withdraw the person's nomination form, and was not elected at that election, and
- c) is still eligible to be elected as a councillor.

Applications must be made using the form **LGCB.203 Application to be a candidate** available from the NSW Electoral Commission website elections.nsw.gov.au. Information about eligibility is available on the application form.

Applications must be lodged with the Returning Officer and close at 12 noon on
