



 - Council has a custodial role in initiating and preparing the Community Strategic Plan, but it is a community plan. Many partners, such as state agencies and community groups, will be responsible for its implementation. The Community Strategic Plan ensures the whole community is working towards a shared vision for a better future.
 - The purpose of today's discussion is to understand as a group why our community is special to us and what we'd like our community to look like in the future.


